Quick Reference Guide

To Place an Outside Call

- 1. Dial 9 + phone number
 - a. You will need to dial 9+1+ full 10 digit number for out of state calls

Transfer a call

- 1. Press: Transfer
- 2. Enter: The extension number
 - a. Hang up to send the call through
 - b. Or wait to announce the call and then hang up to send the call through

Conference Call

While you are on the 1st call

- 1. Press: Conference
- 2. Enter: 9 and the number
 - a. Press Conference
 - **b.** Or wait to announce the call and then press Conference to complete it

Logging into your Mailbox for the 1st Time

- 1. Press: Voice Mail
- 2. Enter: Password 1234 and the pound sign.
- 3. It will prompt you to change your password and say your name.

Record your Voicemail Greeting

- 1. Press: Voice Mail
- 2. Enter: Your password followed by pound.
- 3. Press: 7, 1 to record the greeting for the currently active availability state.
- 4. Follow the prompts to record, replay and save your greeting.

Playing Messages

- 1. Log into the mailbox
 - a. Press 1 to play the new messages
 - b. Press 4 to send a copy of the message to another mailbox
 - c. Press 7 to rewind the message a few seconds
 - d. Press # to go to the next message

2. To delete a message press 3 at any point during the message

Changing the Availability State on your Phone

- 1. Log into your voicemail box
- 2. Press 7 then 2
- 3. Follow the prompts to choose a state:
 - 1. Available
 - 2. In a Meeting
 - 3. Out of Office
 - 4. Vacation
 - 5. Custom

**States 2-5 are set by default to send calls straight to voicemail. You can record a message for each state by first putting your phone into that state, then following steps above to record your greeting.

Star Codes for 420 phones:

Park a call:

- 1. While on the active call press Hold
- 2. Enter *11 and the extension
- 3. Press Pound

Unpark a call:

- 1. Press *12 and enter the extension
- 2. Press Pound

Pickup another ringing phone:

- 1. Press *13 and enter the extension
- 2. Press Pound
